

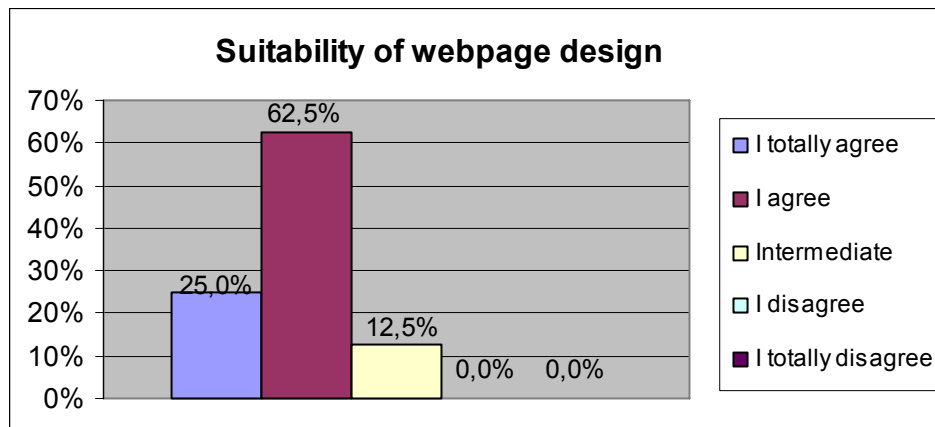
**EVALUATION OF THE PROJECT

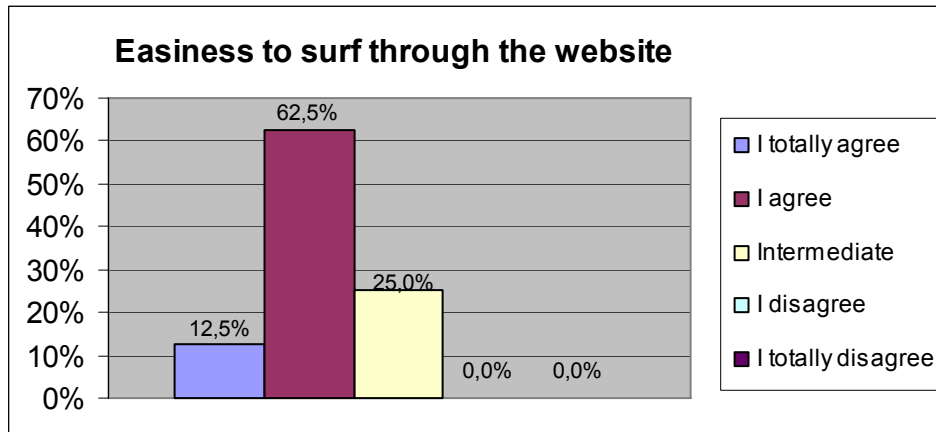
The conclusions resulting from these questionnaires belong to the partners from the following European countries: Belgium, Germany, Greece and Spain.

These are the conclusions resulting from the questionnaires:

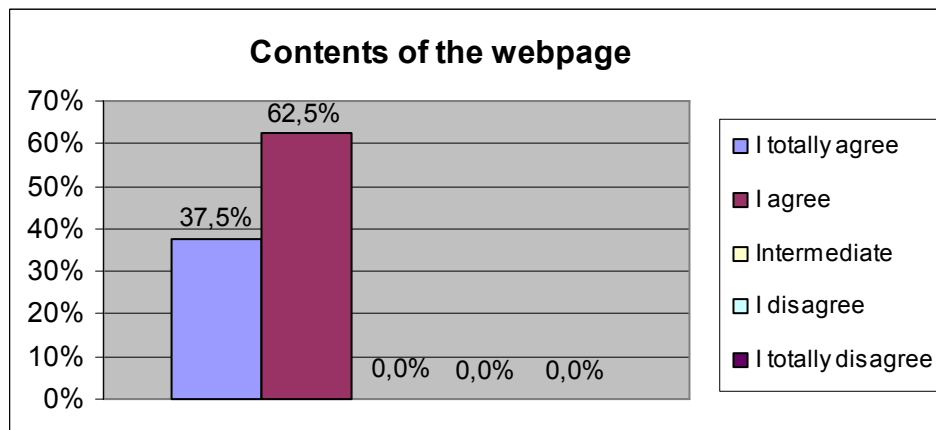
**1. DESIGN AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WEBPAGE**



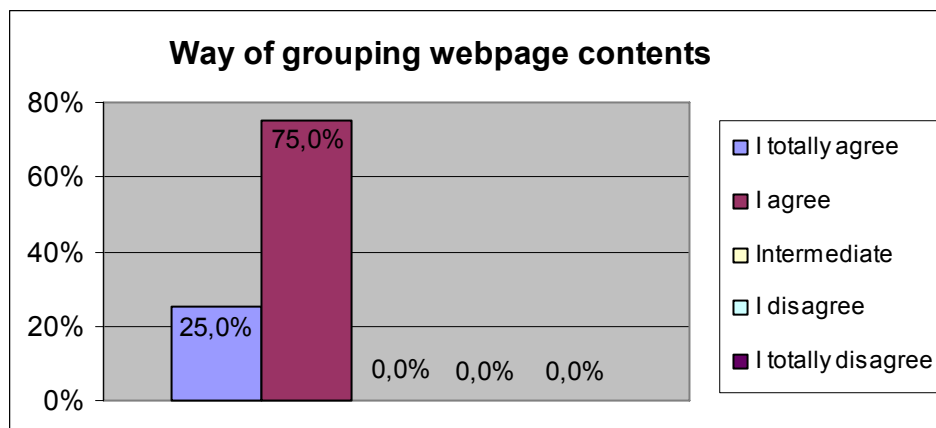
With respect to the suitability of the webpage design (colours, images, etc.), 25% of the partners “Totally agree” and 62,5% “Agree” with the design elaborated by the coordinator. 12,5% of the partners have evaluated the design and implementation of the webpage as “Intermediate”. Nobody “Disagrees” or “Totally disagrees” with the design.



Regarding the easiness to surf through the website, 12,5% of the partners “Totally agree” and 62,5% “Agree” that it is easy to surf through the website. 25% of the partners have evaluated this point as “Intermediate”.

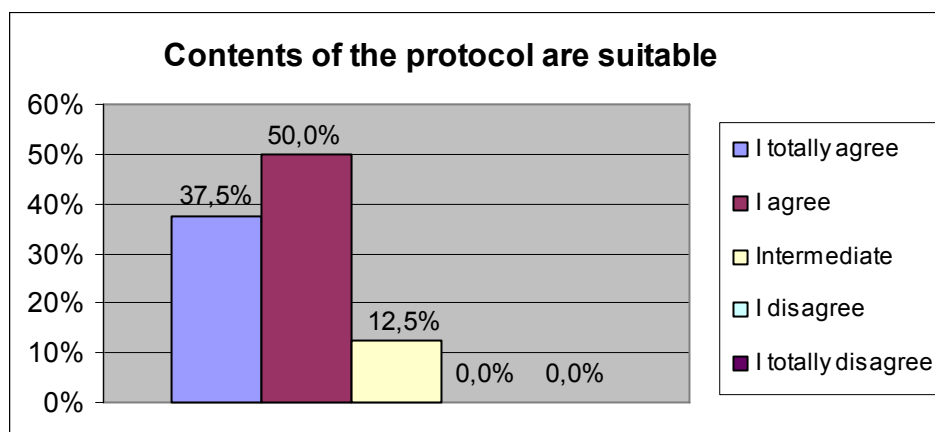


All partners “Totally agree” (37,5%) and “Agree” (62,5%) with the contents that have been placed on the website.

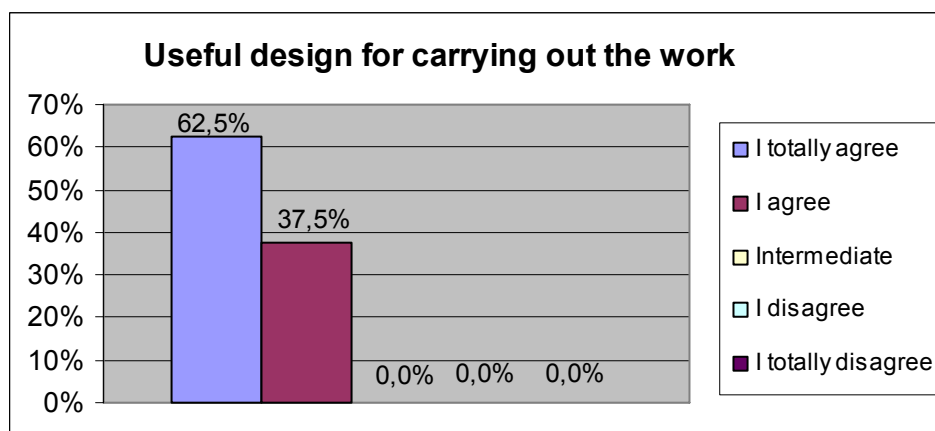


All partners “Totally agree” (25%) and “Agree” (75%) with the way in which the contents of the webpage have been grouped.

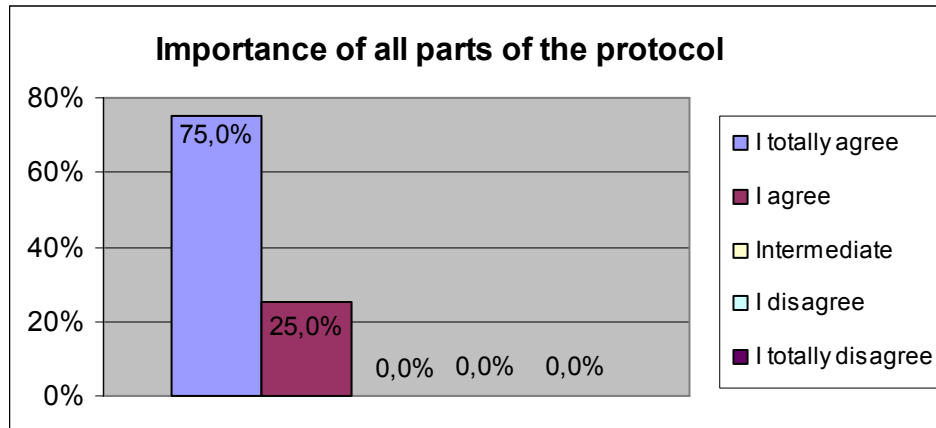
## 2. ELABORATION OF A PROTOCOL FOR THE LEGISLATIVE DATA COLLECTION



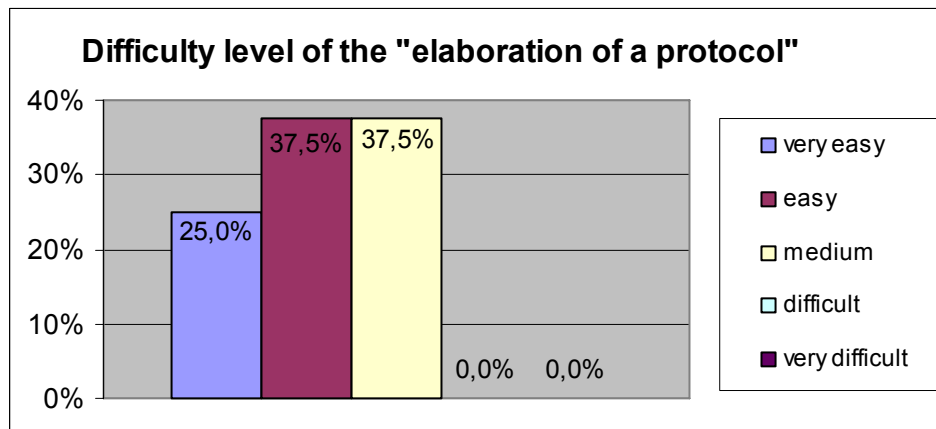
To the question whether the contents of the protocol are suitable, 37,5% of the partners have answered that they “Totally agree” and 50% “Agree” with the contents. 12,5% of the partners have evaluated the contents as “Intermediate”.



62,5% of the partners “Totally agree” and 37,5% “Agree” with the design of the protocol which is very useful for carrying out the legislative data collection.

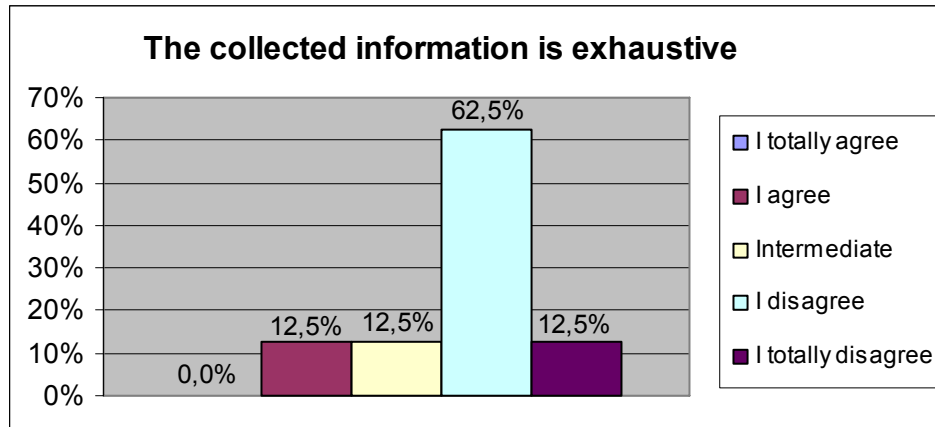


75% of the partners “Totally agree” and 25% “Agree” with the statement that all parts of the protocol are important.

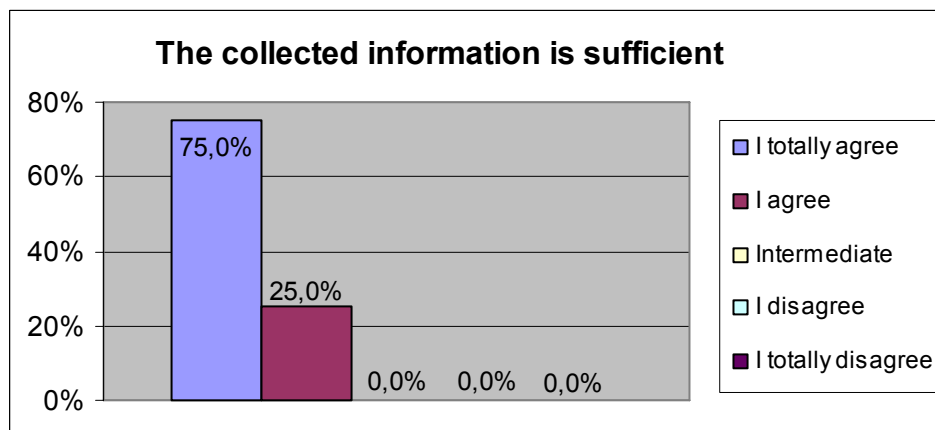


For 25% of the partners, the task of elaborating the protocol was “very easy” and for 37,5% of the partners “easy”. For 37,5% of the partners, this task was neither easy nor difficult. Nobody has evaluated this task as “difficult” or “very difficult”.

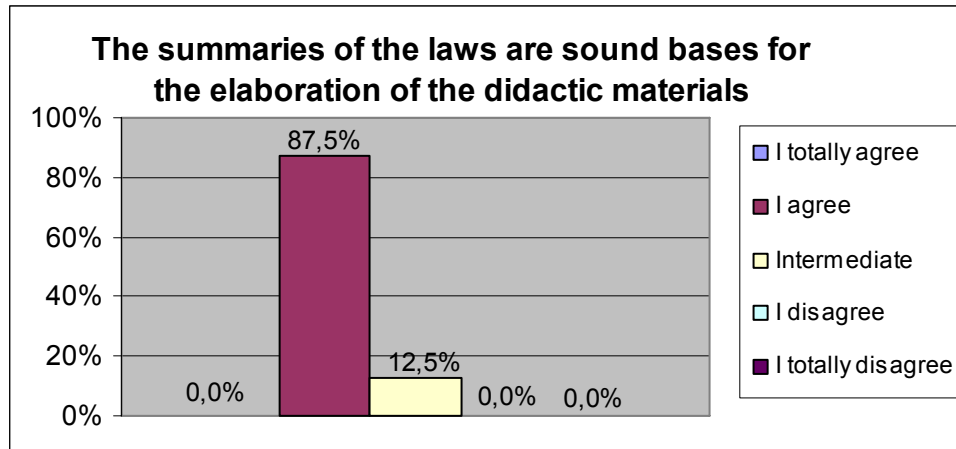
### **3. LEGISLATIVE DATA COLLECTION OF ALL SELECTED SUBJECTS**



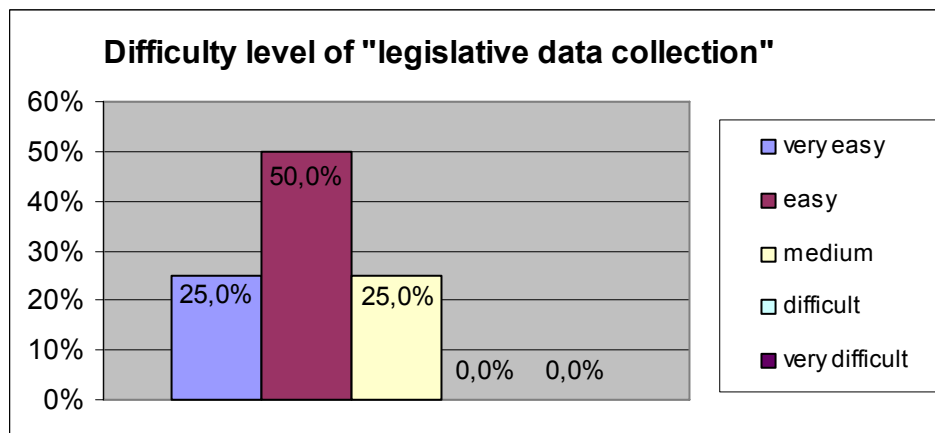
With respect to the legislative data collection, 12,5% of the partners “Agree” that the information is exhaustive. 12,5% of the partners have evaluated this point as “Intermediate”. 62,5% of the partners “Disagree” and 12,5% “Totally disagree” with this statement.



All partners “Totally agree” (75%) and “Agree” (25%) that the collected information is sufficient to carry out the project.



87,5% of the partners believe that the summaries of the laws are sound bases for the elaboration of the didactic materials which will be the base of the future educative actions. 12,5% of partners have evaluated this point as "Intermediate".



For 25% of the partners, the task of collecting legislative data has been "Very easy" and for 50% "Easy". For 25% of the partners, this task was "Neither easy nor difficult". For nobody the task has been "Difficult" or "Very difficult".
