THE MEETING ITSELF

1. - Presentation of participants:

After the words of welcome, on the part of the organizers, each participant gives a short introduction of itself.

- Lithuania: 2 people
- Slovakia: 4 people
- Spain: 5 people
 - Asturias: 3 people
 - Cantabria: 2 people

2. – Working Documents:

A work dossier containing the following documents is given to the participants:

1. Minutes of the meeting held in Oviedo on 10th November 2006.
2. Agenda.
3. Documentary study: EU legislation and Spanish legislation.
4. Questionnaire.
5. Table of work for the survey.

The information for the Lithuanian and Slovakian participants is in English and the meeting is held in this language.

3. - Development of the meeting:

Following the agenda, and after the introductions, the work starts with:

- A) Reading and approval of the minutes of Oviedo's meeting.
- B) Documentary study, the situation is the following:
 - A) In Slovakia, they are in a period of adaptation of the EU legislation. At national level, they have a lack in specific regulation. They have a mediation system between the companies of telephony and Internet, contemplated by the government (official).
 - B) In Lithuania, they adapted the EU legislation and they have an own regulation.
 - C) In Spain, the EU legislation is adapted and has an own regulation.
- C) Survey: each partner is in a different part of the study. It is observed that in the previous meeting, the dates of providing the results have not been fixed in the working timetable. In this situation, it is decided that:
 - Cantabria will send to the rest of the partners the survey in spreadsheet (Excel). Each one of them will complete it with the own results. In addition, an example will be enclosed to gather the results of the same one.

This decision is taken by all partners to unify criteria and to facilitate the elaboration of the formative material.

- D) Web site of the project: It is shown the web site designed by Cantabria and Asturias. It is explained to the other partners that they have to design a similar one. Moreover each webpage must have a link to connect to all other webs.
Cantabria offers their collaboration to the Lithuanian and Slovakian partners for the design of their pages and the corresponding conditions for this work. There will be a communication by e-mail about the decisions to be adopted by each party and how it will be carried out.
- E) Other two points to be treated in the meeting are the contact with the school centres and the communication campaign of the results. It is explained to the partners how it is going to be carried out.
It is still pending the model to be used for the dissemination of results and the mailing to public bodies, mass media and educational centres in each country.

4. – Working timetable and points to be carried out:

- Each partner has to send a document, of maximum two sheets, which contains a summary of the most important aspects of the legislation in each country. This document has to be sent by e-mail in English to the European School of Consumers before 15/05/2007.
 - * Slovakia will work on the EU Directives.

- All partners will send by e-mail a summary (two sheets) of the results of the survey in English to the European School of Consumers, before 30/05/2007. The most significant results (outcomes) will be specified in order to be the basis to elaborate the formative material.

The coordination will send the results of the surveys to each of the partners in order to propose activities for the elaboration of the Learning Plan during the next meeting in Lithuania.

- The Slovakian and Lithuanian partners urgently have to contact the coordinator in order to specify development of the project's Web page.
